

2+2 arrangement between Brown Mackie College and Kansas Wesleyan University

Nursing (BMC) and Nursing – RN to BS (KWU)

In establishing this agreement, Kansas Wesleyan recognizes the coursework and value involved in earning the BMC A.A.S. degree while laying the foundation enabling participating students to also complete KW Bachelor’s degree requirements, all in a total of four years. This agreement will pertain to graduates of the BMC – Salina campus and their branch campuses in Birmingham, AL, Kansas City (Lenexa, KS), and Oklahoma City, OK. 




