

Cost for KWU Students

Since Kansas Wesleyan University has a partnership with TWC, you'll follow the cost arrangements below. It may be helpful to meet with your campus liaison or financial aid office to see exactly how these arrangements will apply to you.

Cost of attendance: You'll pay the TWC program and housing fee, and you'll be able to use your regular financial aid package.

Summer

TWC Program Fee: \$7,100 TWC Housing Fee: + \$4,990 Total TWC Cost = \$12,090

Fall/Spring Semester

TWC Program Fee: \$8,965 TWC Housing Fee: + \$6,290 Total TWC Cost = \$15,255

Credit for KWU Students

You'll earn academic credit from KWU for your semester or summer with TWC. Most KWU students receive the credit amounts listed below, but you should talk to your campus liaison about how these credits will apply.

Fall/Spring Semester: 16 credits

Summer: 11 credits
