ADVANCED PLACEMENT POLICY

Students who have a high school GPA of 3.5 or higher will be considered for priority placement in the nursing class two years after the year of admission to KWU if they fulfill the following criteria:

- Declare nursing as their major upon admission to KWU in the freshman year.
- Demonstrate an ACT composite score of 22 or higher or SAT converted score.
- Achieve a grade of C or higher in all support courses; and
- Maintain a 2.8 cumulative GPA; and
- Complete the criteria of admission to the nursing program.

A letter will be sent to students at the time they are admitted to the university offering them the opportunity to be a part of the Advanced Placement Program if they have a GPA of 3.5 or higher. Students wishing to be considered for Advanced Placement will sign a statement of intention and will meet with a nursing advisor to plan their curriculum. Eligibility for Advanced Placement will be based on the student's GPA at the time of application to KWU. Students will apply to the nursing program just as other students do, but if they meet the criteria listed above they will be placed on the priority list of applicants.
